

Mountain Park Commission
Tuesday, Oct. 16, 1923

A meeting of the Mountain Park Commission was held on the fourteenth floor of the Daniels & Fishers Stores Co building at 12.15.

The entire commission, consisting of Chairman Willcox and Messrs. Downing, MacFarland, Ross, Harvey, Sommers and Steinhauer attending. The minutes of the meeting of Oct. 12th. were read and approved.

Mr Steinhauer was requested to see Mr Rennell, relative to the lots donated to the city for the dam sites at Evergreen and see if he would not allow an extension of time on construction of the dam.

Mr Downing was requested to take up with Clear Creek Commissioners the matter of a road from Echo Lake to Idaho Springs and ascertain to what extent they would contribute towards its construction.

The matter of a budget was discussed and it was finally decided to submit the following budget to the Mayor for his approval.

Maintainance--\$40,000--1/2 of which would be paid for by the state on state roads, this sum to include widening of roads and providing parking spaces.
