

Mountain Park Commission.

Tuesday, Oct. 23, 1923.

A meeting of the Mountain Park Commission was held in the office of Chairman Willcox at the Daniels & Fishers Stores Co building at 12.15 Those present were Chairman Willcox and Messrs. Downing, Harvey, MacFarland, Ross, Vail and Steinhauer. Mayor Stapleton also attended the meeting.

The minutes of the meeting of Oct 16th. were read and Mayor Stapleton suggested that on account of the extraordinary demands for many other civic betterments that were very essential that the proposed budget be reduced from \$125,000 to approximately \$100,000 where upon the committee made the following reductions in their budget items.

Purchase of lands from \$25,000 to \$10,000.

Incidentals from \$20,000 to \$10,000.

The budget then submitted was as follows.
