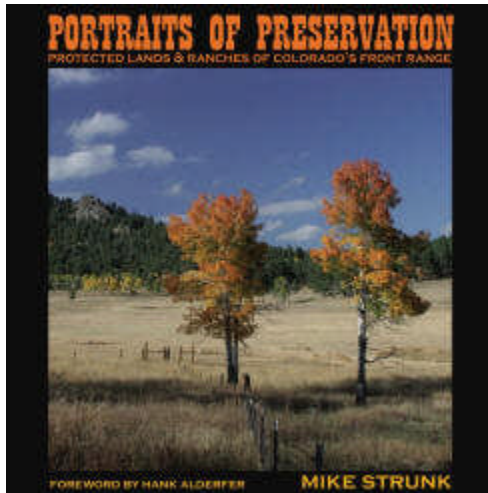


NEW COFFEE TABLE BOOK INCLUDES MANY DMP PARKS!
